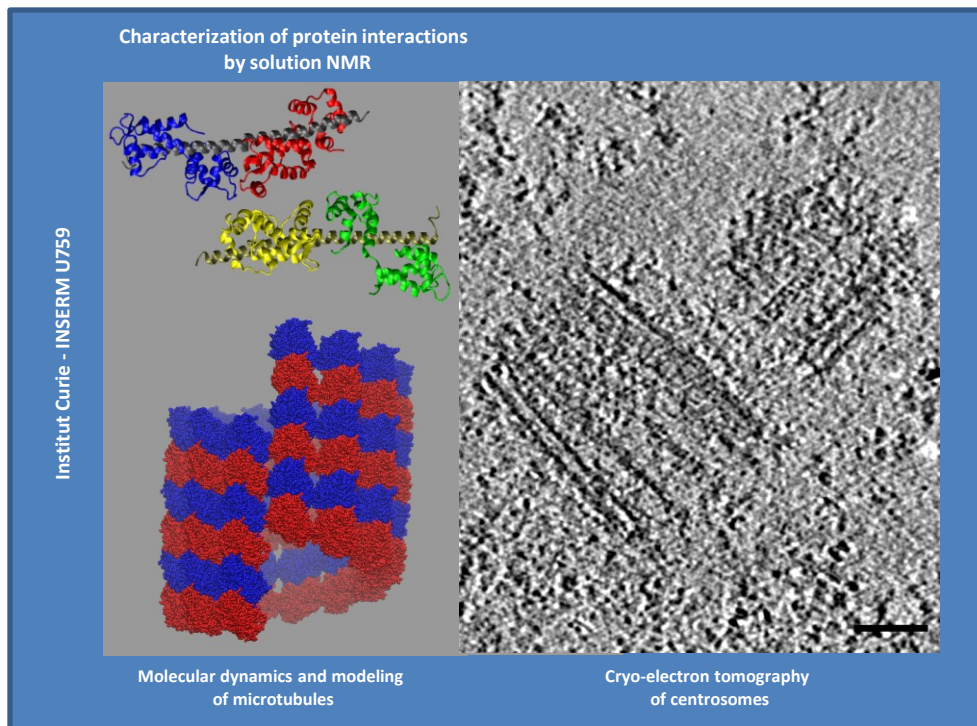


## Group leader position in NMR at Institut Curie

Institut Curie, a leading biomedical research institute devoted to the understanding of normal and cancerous cells, is looking for a junior/senior group leader to join the “Integrative imaging: from molecules to organisms” Department (Institut Curie – INSERM U759).
